Attached is a 2018 Scholarship Application. Applications must be postmarked by **Friday, April 6, 2018**. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

To qualify as the applicant, you must be a graduating high school senior woman who lives in and attends a public or private high school within the DISD or HPISD attendance zones (includes Addison, Highland Park and University Park). If your home address is within the city of Dallas boundaries but you are zoned to attend another school district, you will not qualify. Please note that zip codes will be verified. **Applicants must attend an accredited four-year Texas university with any of the 26 National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) sororities on campus in the academic year following high school graduation. Please see attached list of these 26 NPC sororities. Participation in recruitment for sororities that are not part of the National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) DOES NOT fulfill the requirements of this scholarship.**

Further, the recipient **must** participate in and complete the **NPC** sorority recruitment process. This does not mean that you are required to pledge a NPC sorority, but you must participate in the process before scholarship funds will be distributed to your university. Scholarship funds will be sent to the university upon verification of completion of the recruitment process and it is submitted to the Scholarship Chairman.

The number of scholarships offered varies from year to year depending on available funds. **Scholarships of at least \$1000 will be awarded based upon academic achievement, extra-curricular activities, and financial need.**

Scholarship recipients will be notified by early May and recognized at our annual Scholarship Luncheon on May 16, 2018 at Royal Oaks Country Club. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact me and we look forward to receiving your scholarship application.

Applicants must attend an accredited four-year Texas university with National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) sororities on campus in the academic year following high school graduation. Participation in recruitment for sororities that are not part of the National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) DOES NOT fulfill the requirements of this scholarship. **A list of the eligible Texas universities with NPC sororities on campus** as well as **a list of the 26 NPC sororities and links to their websites** can be found at www.dallaspanhellenic.org under the Scholarships link.

The number of scholarships offered varies from year to year depending on available funds. Scholarship(s) of at least \$1000 will be awarded based upon academic achievement, extra-curricular activities, and financial need.

The recipient must participate in and complete the NPC sorority recruitment process. This does not mean that she is required to pledge a sorority, but she must participate in the process before scholarship funds will be distributed to her university. Scholarship funds will be sent directly to the university upon verification of completion of the recruitment process.
